The Dragonara Castle, built in the 13th century, originally served defensive purposes to protect the village from pirate attacks. Today, the castle is open to the public and hosts cultural events and exhibitions. Visiting the castle allows one to immerse in Camogli's maritime history and enjoy spectacular coastal views.

Today in Camogli, visitors can enjoy a variety of activities. Relax on the sandy beaches or at charming beach clubs.
