Lake Molveno and the Brenta Dolomites

A corner of paradise in the heart of Trentino: Lake Molveno enchants visitors with its turquoise waters, set at the foot of the spectacular Brenta Dolomites. Offering hiking, sports, and relaxation, it is the perfect destination to enjoy nature, beauty, and adventure in every season.

Molveno, a jewel of western Trentino, lies at an altitude of 864 metres on the shores of the lake that bears its name, at the foot of the Brenta Dolomites. The charming, well-kept village lives in perfect harmony with a turquoise lake surrounded by forests, meadows and beaches. Rising behind it are the spectacular peaks of the Brenta Dolomites, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, which turn shades of pink at sunset and create breathtaking scenery. Molveno is an ideal destination for hiking, water sports and scenic walks. By car, it can be reached from the A22 motorway via the San Michele all'Adige or Trento Nord exits; travellers arriving by train can reach Trento and continue by bus.

A destination where nature, mountains and relaxation come together in perfect balance throughout the year. The complete circuit of Lake Molveno follows the "Giro del Lago" loop trail, with convenient starting points at the Lido or near the main beach. The route is approximately 11 kilometres long and usually takes around 2.5 to 3 hours to complete, excluding stops. It is an easy, mostly flat and well-marked trail, alternating between lakeside paths, woodland, footbridges and a few short uphill sections. Along the way, walkers can discover the Roman Bridge, a waterfall, the Napoleonic Fortifications and, towards the southern end of the lake, the Nembia area.

The trail is suitable for hikers of all ages, families and children accustomed to walking. Large sections can also be tackled with a stroller, although roots, stones and a few uneven passages require some care. Comfortable footwear, water and clothing suitable for the weather are recommended. Lake Molveno and the Brenta Dolomites offer a unique setting, where turquoise waters, forests and spectacular peaks create a perfect balance between nature and beauty. A destination to enjoy in every season, ideal for those seeking relaxation, hiking and unforgettable views. Molveno is an invitation to set off, breathe deeply and let yourself be captivated.
